National Miners Day marks the anniversary of the worst mining accident in history on December 6, 1907, in Monogah, West Virginia. The disaster resulted in the deaths of 362 miners. In 2009, Congress proclaimed the day to be observed each year on December 6.

Safety and Community Relations teamed up this year to provide an evening of holiday fun and appreciation for miners and their families. 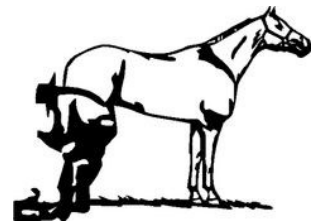

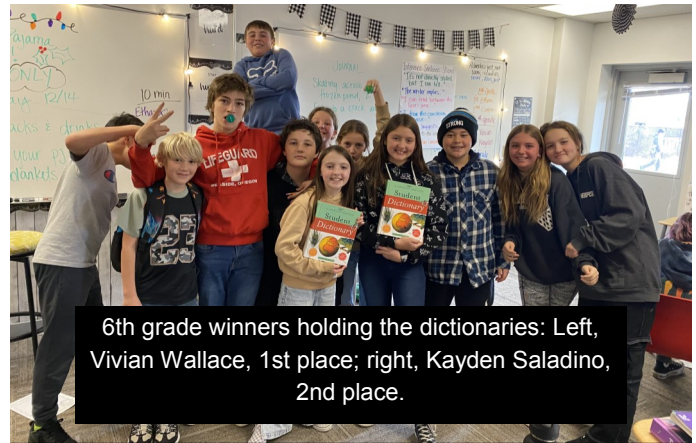
